The successful candidate (any gender) will have specialized in American Literature and Culture and will be able to represent the discipline in its entirety. Research foci in literary theory and cultural theory as well as US-American literature of the twentieth and twenty-first centuries are required; overlap between the research interests represented at the English Department and applicants' own research interests is desired.

The successful candidate will have experience in the acquisition of competitive external funding and be willing to engage in interdisciplinary, externally funded research collaborations and to participate in academic self-government.

Applicants need to provide proof of pedagogical aptitude. The successful candidate is expected to cater to the Department of English's interdisciplinary course offerings. Teaching and advising duties pertain to the following courses: B.A. and M.A. Culture and Economy, B.Ed. and M.Ed. English, B.A. Current English Linguistics and Literary Studies (CELLS), B.Sc. und M.Sc. Economic and Business Education with a Minor in English as well as Literature, Media and Culture in the Modern Era.

The legal prerequisites of the appointment are stipulated by §§ 47–48 LHG of the state of Baden-Württemberg. The University of Mannheim is committed to increasing the representation of women in research and teaching, and, thus, encourages women to apply. Applications by individuals with a severe disability who display aptitude will be treated with preference.
