Only recent and unpublished work (Dr/PhD theses or post-doctoral theses [*Habilitationsschriften*] completed within the 24-month period prior to the submission deadline) will be considered. For the current round, this means work **completed in 2024 and 2025**.

Submissions should include a letter of recommendation (indicative length: 2 pages; alternatively: *Gutachten der Dissertation*). The deadline for submissions is **31 December 2025**.
