The Faculty of Arts at Friedrich Schiller University Jena seeks to fill a

## **Professorship (W1) without tenure track for junior scholars, “Anglophone Literatures in a Global Environment”**

from the next possible date.

The professorship seeks to widen the scope of research and teaching in English and American studies to a global perspective by focusing on anglophone literatures and cultures beyond the UK and North America, including the increasingly important anglophone literatures in areas not previously part of the Commonwealth.

The applicant (m/f/d) must have obtained an outstanding PhD in English/American studies and must have a pertinent research focus in an anglophone culture and literature, such as, e.g., Australia, the Caribbean, or India. An additional research focus in a global anglophone literature (e.g., in African English literature) as well as a viable international research network are of advantage.

We expect pedagogical aptitude, high-quality teaching integrating innovative methods, the willingness to collaborate in the research priorities of the faculty, and commitment in the acquisition of third-party funds.

Future tasks include teaching in the BA and MA programmes BA English/American Studies, MA English/American studies, MA North American Studies, and teachers' training. All classes are taught in English. Moreover, appropriate participation in self-administration is expected.

To be eligible for the position, candidates must have a completed university degree and a particular aptitude for academic work, which is usually demonstrated by the outstanding quality of a doctorate. The total period of doctoral studies and employment should not have exceeded six years. The professorship is initially limited to four years. After a positive interim evaluation, it will be extendable by a further two years.

Friedrich Schiller University Jena aims to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching and therefore strongly encourages suitably qualified female academics to apply.

Severely disabled persons will be given preferential consideration in case of equal suitability.
